



In the scope of the project – by means of more than 20 information events and workshops - NGOs will be encouraged to foster national, cross-border and international partnerships around various priority areas and issues of the EUSDR. Participating NGOs will be given the opportunity to cooperate in the creation and exploitation of opportunities for volunteer work related to the Danube Strategy.

The project will lay the foundations of a network for NGOs (DANUBENET), interested in the implementation of the EUSDR.

Discussing on whether and how the EUSDR was implemented as stipulated by the European Parliament and how NGOs can participate in the preparation, implementation, monitoring, evaluation of the EUSDR /European Parliament resolution of 17 February 2011 on the implementation of the EU Strategy for the Danube Region (P7\_TA-PROV(2011)0065) # 16/;

- Discussing on the topics mentioned in the Danubenet project
- Preparation of existing EUSDR projects and collaboration to generate other projects, e.g. "Danube Pearls Livable riverbanks"



# Project object



Organizing more than 20 conferences in 11 countries in which 50 representatives of NGOs (5 local participants and 45 from the neighbouring countries) will participate.

The topics of the EUSDR priority areas and special topics by the DaNet project are mentioned in the following tables.

Additional objectives: Rhine-Main-Danube Canal and Danube Strategy (Germany), transcontinental impact of the Danube Strategy (Netherlands), river network system in Western Europe to the Danube basin (Belgium), Europe2020 strategy and the EUSDR

Establishing the civil forum for EUSDR – the Danubenet for NGOs and its Congress as a supranational cooperation at the closing conference which will take place in Budapest on the 29-th of June – the International Day of the Danube river. Therefore the functions, activities and operational rules of the Danubenet for NGOs will be a common topic on all conferences.

The aim of the first conference, that is to take place in Budapest is to prepare all partners for the realization of the conferences.

**EU** - The project management team and the partner organizations will be closely working together with the European Commission Directorate General for Regional Policy, as well as with the national governmental bodies responsible for the Danube Strategy.





# Programme of all events

- 1. Information and Forum of EUSDR and Priorities by role of the host country and with possible links to the NGO activities;
- 2. Workshop for project generation in the context of the given country's role in the EUSDR;
- 3. Consultation, exchange of expertise the role of DANUBENET in the development of national networks
- 4. Preparation of the DANUBENET CONGRESS

The Programmeme of the series of events will cover all the 11 priority areas of the Danube Strategy. The Programmeme of the individual conferences will be established by the Organizing Committee chaired by the local partner organization. All the events will include 1) a conference with speakers from national governments and expert organizations 2) a workshop which will address specific issues using the Open Space Workshop method 3) a forum facilitating partner search, networking and project generation. The organizers will also ensure the widest possible media coverage of the event (press conference, press releases).



# Expected Results



The final event of the series will be the DANUBENET Congress to be held in Budapest in June 2012, aiming to give a proper institutional framework to the newly established cooperation.

As another outcome, the project will lead to significant awareness raising related to the Danube Strategy within the NGO sector in participating countries. The project will also encourage NGOs to take initiatives and get involved actively in the implementation of the EUSDR Action Plan.
