- Territory of "Seine-Aval" has chosen to involve the 3
 European funds from the beginning programming period
 2007-2013 to provide coherence to the various themes of the ERDF, ESF and EAFRD:
- Employment, training, health center, economic development, sustainable urban development, biomass, eco-materials, ecoconstruction ...
- The Integrated Urban Plan IUP is the equivalent of (investment territorial instrument) ITI proposed for the next programming period by the commission.



Presentation and characteristics of the (project) area

- The "Seine-Aval" is localized along the "Seine" river in the west of Paris,
- Organized along the axis of the river and presenting remarkable landscapes,
- A "Mixed" territory: urban and peri-urban areas with many natural and agricultural lands,



Presentation and characteristics of the (project) area


- The Seine- Aval is a territory of 398 km² and a population of over 370 000 inhabitants,
- Agricultural area representing 30% of the territory (thirty farms).
- Concentration of urban and economic activities in the valley,



Type of territory and composing / development process

- The Seine-Aval (identified as an area of strategic development)
- But was in industrial decline with different levels of development in urban areas.
- Its development is supported by a National Interest Operation NIO since 2006 involving the State, the Region Ile-de-France, the local authorities of Yvelines, 51 municipalities and 5 groups of municipalities.

Type of territory and composing / development process

- **EPAMSA** which is a public establishment manages the operation (OIN).
- Shortly before, an Integrated Urban Plan IUP started with an application submitted under a call for proposals for axis 1 (urban) "In Europe" in the framework of the regional OP- ERDF. (IUP is the equivalent of ITI proposed for the next programming period).
- In 2007 the **LEADER** experience (the first in Ile-de-France) was also supported by EPAMSA.



Type of territory and composing / development process

•Through these 3 initiatives, local authorities have expressed their willingness to make a real cooperation project of development.

•This collective approach facilitated the creation of links between agricultural and urban worlds (LEADER), and allowed to contribute to the implementation of the major projects (NIO) and (IUP).



The experience acquired by the territory

- The territory of Seine-Aval has local engineering resources and strong organizational capacities.
- Across the inter-urban areas, as well as serious experience in both urban development actions and in managing the Structural Funds.

Objectives: several segments are integrated within the project "**In'Europe**" Seine-Aval:

- A development axis with the ERDF, with a common interest to the 3 urban centers (coordinated by EPAMSA).
- An employment section, which aims at economic development through the strengthening and development of training courses related to ecoindustries, eco-construction, services to the population and local entrepreneurship support.



Objectives

- Therefore the ESF and the ERDF, are complementary in the context of development planning policy of the Seine-Aval.
- EAFRD supports actions to preserve the agricultural component. These actions aim at fighting against urban sprawl and supporting new practices and experimental development of local agricultural resources.
- They promote also links and interaction between agricultural and urban actors/stakeholders.



Process

•Under the National Interest operation, "Seine Aval" won a call for projects whose name is "In Europe" in the framework of **ERDF** (2007-2013)

•Concerning the management of the **ESF**, local authorities decided to maintain 3 grant agreements.

•EAFRD /LEADER: 1 070 000 €

Focus on one project of LAG Seine-Aval Background:

- The plain of Chanteloup-les-Vignes receives the spreading of sewage for over 100 years.
- 300 Ha of farmland are polluted, food crops are not allowed,
- Now partly land is left fallow.



- The aim is to transform these fragile and abandoned areas in a "green heart", integrating agriculture as a means of structuring the urbanization
- The LAG Seine-Aval leads a local development strategy that priority is **urban-rural link**, among other things.



Focus on one project of LAG Seine-Aval Objectives

• The goal is to reclaim landscapes and agricultural areas and develop an agro-resources sector.

 The idea is to use plantation of Miscanthus: nonfood crop growing areas, tolerance to pollution, ability to retain pollutants, carbon footprint, ability to create a economic chain ...

Summary presentation

- A first experimental phase of implementation of Miscanthus rhizomes covers 7.4 ha of lowland
- The aim is to reach 150-200 ha of crops with significant levels of profitability and the development of different sectors related to green building
- The establishment of 35 ha of miscanthus was carried out in 2012, and 82 additional hectares in 2014.



Results

This project combines several objectives:

- Agronomic (experiment miscanthus)
- Environmental (sequestration capacity of pollutants)
- Economic and social (that will be measured by specific indicators).
- The first results are agronomic, with the success of the experiment that allows to further the development..

keys to success

 The link between funds, makes a sense in the Seine-Aval area. If projects and structural installations are essential to enable the Seine-Aval becoming attractive (ERDF), the value of agricultural land is equally important to treat periurban agricultural issues at the local and regional level (EAFRD) for enployement and human capital (ESF).

Challenge for the future

• The constraints of EU funds management: arising from differences in logic intervention, procedures and referent services between funds.

• To develop training for manager to help them to coordinate the different funds (new skills, new internal organization in local authorities)
